**The Parent/Guardian Must Read and Understand this Waiver Prior to Infant Participating in Exhibition Activities**

The following waiver of all claims, release from all liability, assumption of all risks, agreement not to sue and other terms of this agreement are entered into by me on behalf of the Infant Participant named below with and for the benefit of: \_\_\_\_\_

\_\_\_\_\_, its directors, officers, employees, volunteers, business operators, agents, and site property owners or lessees (the "Host"). Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, "Exhibition Activities" includes but is not limited to any hot air balloon, bungee jump, ejection seat, animal ride or to the riding, handling, wrestling, or controlling of any unbroken or imperfectly broken animal, or to any form of rodeo, sporting event, race, stunt activity, motor sport, grandstand show, talent show, or to any other performance or demonstration for public entertainment which may be conducted by the "Host".

**Initial Each Item below after Reading and Understanding each item:**

- \_\_\_\_\_ 1. I am the Parent/Guardian of the Infant Participant and am executing this waiver on behalf of the Infant Participant in my capacity as Parent/Guardian and with the intent that his waiver be binding on myself and the Infant for all legal purposes.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2. I am aware that there are inherent dangers, hazards and risks (collectively "Risks") associated with "Exhibition Activities" and injuries resulting from these "Risks" are a common occurrence. I am aware that the "Risks" of "Exhibition Activities" mean those dangerous conditions which are an integral part of "Exhibition Activities", including but not limited to:
  - (a) the propensity of any animals to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm or death to persons on or around them and to potentially collide with, bite or kick other animals, people or objects;
  - (b) the unpredictability of an animal's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement, tremors, vibrations, unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals and hazards such as subsurface objects;
  - (c) the potential for other participants to behave in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to themselves or others, including failing to act within their abilities;
  - (d) the potential for spectators to behave in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to participants or others;
  - (e) the potential for buildings, materials, equipment or supplies to malfunction, fail, collapse or cause electric shock.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 3. I freely accept and fully assume all responsibility for all "Risks" and possibilities of any and all personal injury, death, property damage or loss resulting from the Infant Participant's participation in "Exhibition Activities".

I agree that although the "Host" has taken steps to reduce the "Risks" and increase the safety of the "Exhibition Activities", it is not possible for the "Host" to make the "Exhibition Activities" completely safe. I accept these "Risks" and agree to the terms of this waiver on behalf of the Infant Participant, even if the "Host" is found to be negligent or in breach of any duty of care or any obligation to myself or the Infant Participant in the Infant's participation in "Exhibition Activities".

In addition to consideration given to the "Host" for the Infant Participant's participation in "Exhibition Activities", I and my heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators and assigns, as well as the Infant Participant and his/her heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators and assigns (collectively our "Legal Representatives") agree:
  - (a) to waive all claims that the Infant Participant has or may have in the future against the "Host";
  - (b) to release and forever discharge the "Host" from all liability for personal injury, death, property damage, or loss that I, the Infant Participant, or our "Legal Representatives" might suffer as a result of the Infant Participant's participation in "Exhibition Activities" due to any cause, including but not limited to negligence (failure to use such care as a reasonably prudent and careful person would use under similar circumstances), breach of any duty imposed by law, breach of contract or mistake or error in judgment of the "Host"; and
  - (c) to be liable for and to hold harmless and indemnify the "Host" from all actions, proceedings, claims, damages, costs demands, including court costs and costs on a solicitor and own client basis, and liabilities of whatsoever nature or kind arising out of or in any way connected with the Infant's participation in "Exhibition Activities".

## Code of Conduct

### 1.1 All DCEA Participants will:

- a) Consistently demonstrate the spirit of sportsmanship, sport leadership and ethical conduct in the best interest of the safety of all participants and animals, and the integrity of the sport of competing and the DCEA Exhibition;
- b) Ensure their participation, and the participation of any and all individuals associated with their Exhibit, in the DCEA is conducted in accordance with the DCEA Rules and Regulations and the Code of Conduct;
- c) Promote a safe sporting environment by avoiding any behaviors on the Exhibition grounds before, during and after the Competition - that compromises the safety of other competitors or animals
- d) Ensure responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their Animals as well as Animals placed in their care for any purpose;
- e) Provide for the continuous well-being of animals by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, sanitation and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure; -
- f) Treat all other participants with respect and dignity, and avoid any actions that might threaten or intimidate any person or organization involved in the Exhibition, including spectators, sponsors, other Exhibitors, Judges, Officials, Staff and Volunteers;
- g) Exhibit standards of professional behavior which will maintain public confidence and trust in the integrity of the DCEA, the sport of competing;
- h) Refrain from publicly criticizing the manner in which the Judges, Exhibition or Exhibition Officials perform their duties or resolve any dispute or disciplinary matter resulting from a breach of the DCEA Rules and Regulations and or Code of Conduct;
- i) Cooperate in the enforcement of the Rules and Regulations and Code of Conduct, and agree to accept the authority and decisions of the Judges, Exhibition Safety Commission and Exhibition Officials;

1.2 Exhibitors shall be subject to sanctions by the DCEA Exhibition Safety Commission if they are found to have breached the Code of Conduct.

We also believe that all rodeo events, and rodeo animal welfare practices in sanctioned and approved Pro Rodeo's, Chuckwagon's and Agriculture Fair events should be observed and viewed only on an animal by animal basis, not by the event(s) animals are in.

The Dawson Creek Exhibition Association does not support animal rights philosophies that call for the end of all use and interaction with animals. Animal rights in its purest form, focuses on whether humans have the right to view and use animals as partners or resources.
